## **Symptom**

I cannot start my virtual machine with the following error messages:

## Resolution

Problem ID: 374

- 1. Click OK button to close the notification window.
- 2. Open Parallels Desktop Control Center: right-click on the Parallels Desktop icon in the **Dock**, then select **Control Center** (Virtual Machines list in older versions).
- 3. Right-click on the virtual machine you want to remove and click **Remove** then press **Keep files**

- 4. Locate your virtual machine on your Mac hard drive
- 5. Double-click on your virtual machine's .pvm file to start it. Your virtual machine will be registered in the Parallels Desktop **Control Center** again.
