

## How to restore 'pvm' file from the Time Machine?

- Parallels Desktop
- Parallels Desktop for Mac App Store Edition
- Parallels Desktop for Mac Pro Edition
- Parallels Desktop for Mac Business Edition

## **Symptom**

I need to restore Virtual Machine from the Time Machine backup.

## Resolution

- 1. Enter Time Machine.
- 2. Choose the date for the back up to be restored.
- 3. Locate the '.pvm' file from

```
Mac HD/Users/Shared/Parallels (location by default)
```

- 4. To restore, select the file/folder and click the **"Restore"** button. The file will automatically be copied to the desktop or appropriate folder.
- 5. If the file you are restoring has another file in the same location with the same name, you will be prompted to choose which file to keep or keep both.
