

## Unable to use a virtual machine with another Mac user account

- Parallels Desktop
- Parallels Desktop for Mac Standard Edition
- Parallels Desktop for Mac Business Edition
- Parallels Desktop for Mac Pro Edition

# **Symptoms**

A virtual machine can't be used with several Mac user accounts. After you log into **User 2** and launch a virtual machine on the **User 1** account, a virtual machine looks like:

At User 1 account virtual machine launch is followed by the following notification:

"Unable to complete the operation for "Windows ". The virtual machine ID is invalid. To resolve the

#### Cause

Parallels Desktop misconfiguration.

### Resolution

- 1. Log into your main user account.
- 2. Be sure that **Parallels Desktop for Mac** is quit.
- 3. Open the **Terminal.app** from **Applications** > **Utilities**.
- 4. In the **Terminal** window execute the following command:

```
sudo rm -rf /Library/Preferences/Parallels/
```

**NOTE**: No symbols will be shown due to security measures, so just hit the keys and use return/Enter.

5. Execute the command below in **Terminal**:

```
rm -rf ~/Library/Preferences/Parallels/
```

6. Now execute this command:

```
rm -rf ~/Library/Parallels/
```

- 7. Perform steps 2 5 for each user account you intent to use a virtual machine.
- 8. Login under another user account and add the virtual machine to Parallels Desktop Control Center (double click on the .pvm bundle).

NOTE: By default, shared virtual machines are located in the folder

```
/Users/Shared/Parallels
```
