



How to allow Mac to boot from external media

Information

In order to allow a **Mac** with T2 Chip to boot from **PMM USBBoot** you need to allow the **Mac** to boot from external media:

- Turn on your **Mac**, then press and hold **Command (?) - R** immediately after you see the **Apple** logo to start up from **macOS Recovery**.
- When you see the **macOS Utilities** window, choose **Utilities > Startup Security Utility** from the menu bar.

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- When you're asked to authenticate, click 'Enter macOS password', then choose a local administrator account and enter its password.

In **Startup Security Utility**:

1. Set **Secure Boot** option to '*No Security*'.
2. Set **External Boot** to '*Allow booting from external media*'.

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
